The purpose of this Multi-Campus Articulation Agreement is to continue partnership between the above campuses and to facilitate a smooth transition for students in the Associate in Science in Early Childhood Education (ECE) programs at Hawai'i Community College, Honolulu Community College, Kaua'i Community College and the University of Hawai'i Maui College to the University of Hawai'i West O'ahu, as they work toward obtaining the Bachelor of Arts in Social Sciences degree with a concentration in Early Childhood Education (ECE). It is the intention of this articulation agreement that transferring students complete both AS and BA degrees therefore recommended pathways have been identified. All campuses indicated above agree to work collaboratively to update and share program changes. A committee comprised of academic advisors and/or faculty from each campus will be established to oversee and maintain updates to the general education pathways and program requirements.

The UH West O'ahu Articulation Option Recommendations listed in Attachments I-IV represent the most efficient coursework progression from the AS through the BA program. To maximize the number of credits that will apply toward the baccalaureate degree at UHWO, students are advised to complete the UHWO Articulation Option Recommendation indicated for their home campus and consult with a Counselor or Program Advisor at their respective Community College or a Student Services Specialist at UHWO for the most efficient transfer possible. Although individual course substitutions may be made on a case-by-case basis, all UHWO core, general education, focus, and graduation requirements must still be met in those individual cases.

Admission to UH West O'ahu

At minimum, students who wish to enter UHWO's BA in Social Science degree program with a concentration in Early Childhood Education must be eligible for transfer admission by the time of application and should complete the 32 credits of ECE Core identified below and the prerequisite coursework in Math and English required for the BA program prior to transfer. The identified AS ECE core, listed below, is aligned with the UHWO BA ECE program requirements for continuity and maximum professional development.

Enrollment in 300 and 400 level UHWO ECE and Social Science courses requires completion of the identified ECE Core (32 credits), Math (103) and English (100) prerequisites. Any exceptions will require approval from UHWO ECE faculty.

This agreement supports the completion of the AS ECE degree either prior to transfer or via reverse credit transfer. Interested students are encouraged to seek guidance from a Counselor or Program Advisor at their respective Community College for more information on options for AS-ECE degree completion. Students transferring prior to the completion of the AS-ECE degree will need to meet the UHWO requirements for admission for their designated term of entry, and will be responsible to complete all UHWO core, degree, concentration, general education, focus and graduation requirements in place at the time of their admission to UHWO.

AS-Early Childhood Education Transfer:

Students who complete the Associate in Science (AS) degree in Early Childhood Education (ECE) prior to transfer may be accepted as classified students to the UHWO's Bachelor of Art (BA) in Social Sciences degree with a concentration in Early Childhood Education through the University of Hawai'i Automatic Admissions process, provided that eligibility, deadlines and procedures established for their designated term of entry are met. Completion of the AS program prior to transfer will enable students to follow the UHWO core, degree, concentration, general education, focus, and graduation requirements in place on the Effective Date of this agreement. For students who complete the AS ECE degree but not all of the recommended coursework for UHWO, additional lower division coursework to complete the general education requirements for UHWO may be required and completed after admission to UHWO. Current requirements for the AS degrees and the BA degree form the basis for this agreement, and subsequent changes to the curricular requirements of either program may require revisions to this agreement.

This Articulation Agreement is in effect beginning Fall 2015 and will remain in effect until Spring 2019. It will be subject to review in Spring 2019, and may be continued, revised or discontinued with the consent of individual or all parties. If any or all parties consent to the termination of this agreement, HAW, HON, KAU and MAU students who have entered the AS in Early Childhood Education program by Spring 2019 will have the option of transferring to UH West O'ahu to fulfill any remaining requirements identified within the recommended academic pathways, contingent upon courses being offered.




