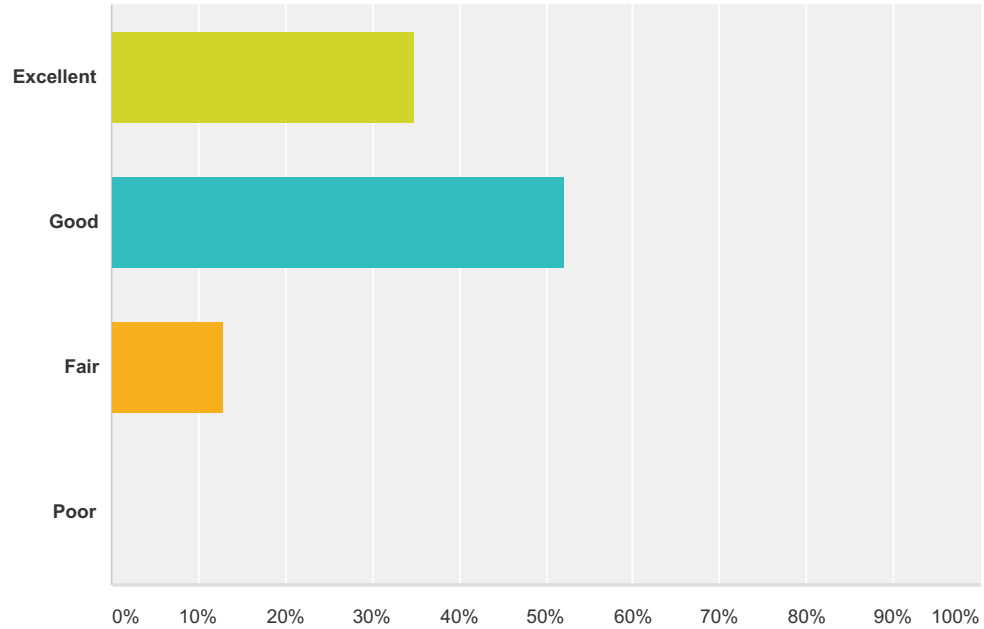

Q1 How would you rate the overall quality of your academic experience at Hawaii Community College?

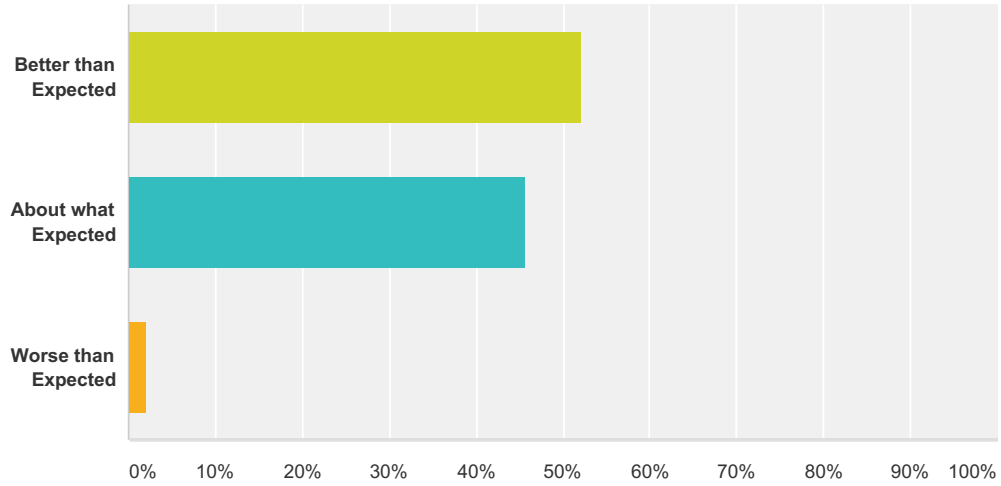

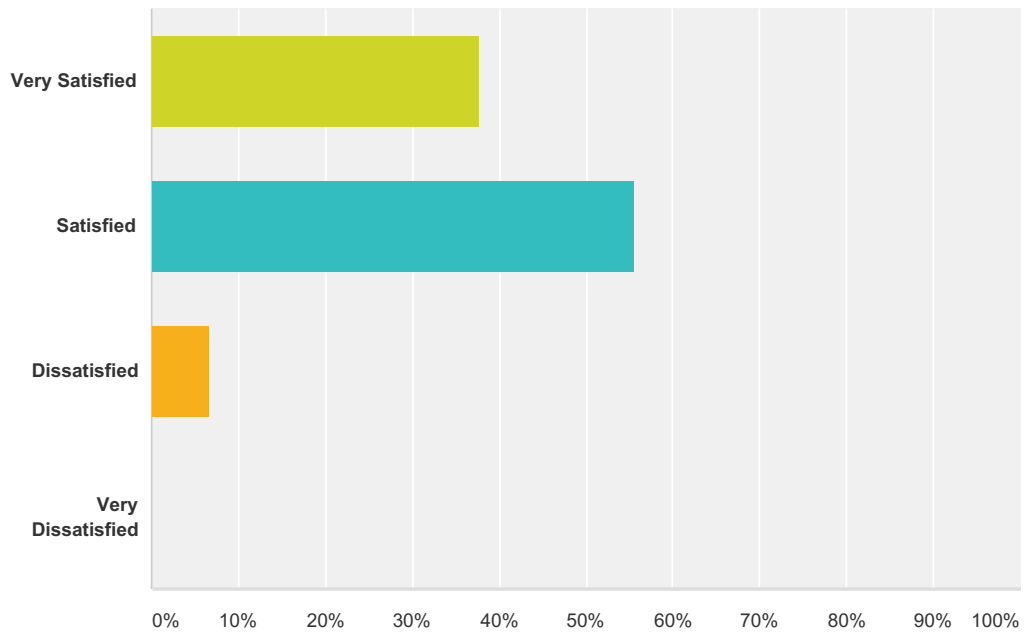

Q3 How satisfied were you with the academic preparation you received?

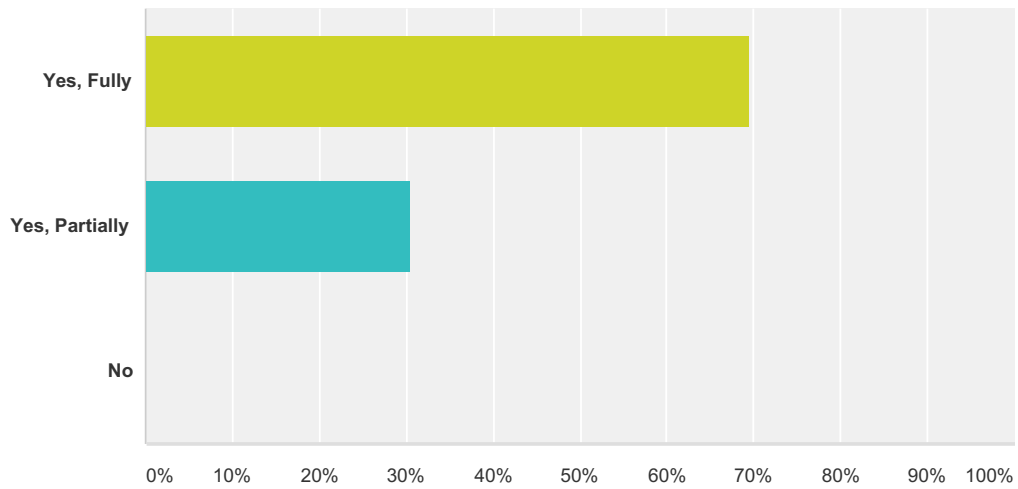

Q4 Did you achieve your educational objective?

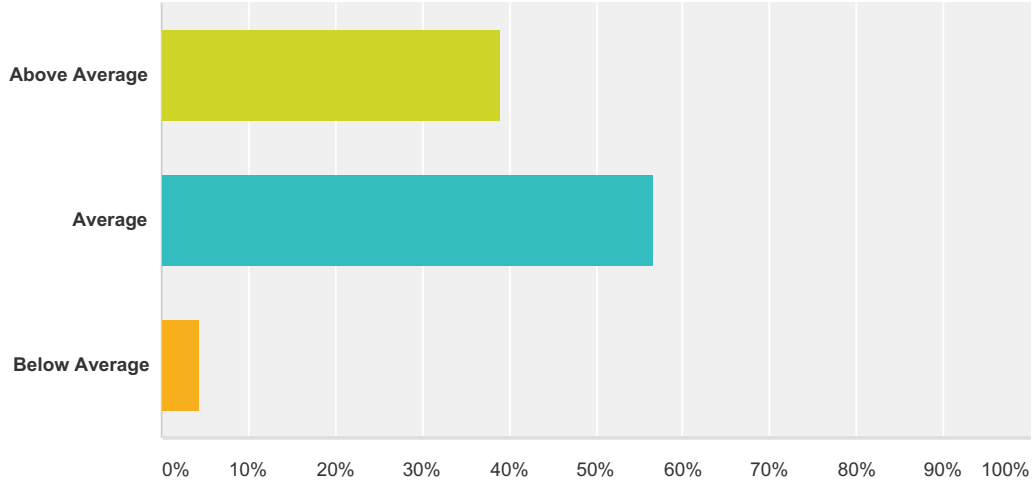

Q5 How would you rate the quality of your degree or certificate from Community College?

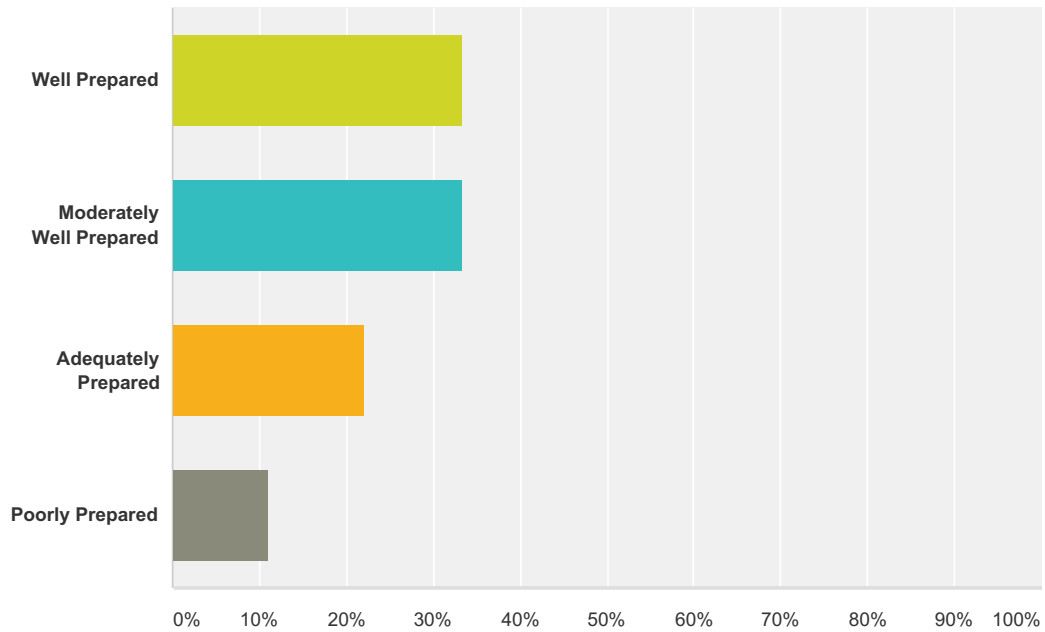

Q6 How well did the education and training you received prepare you for your current job?

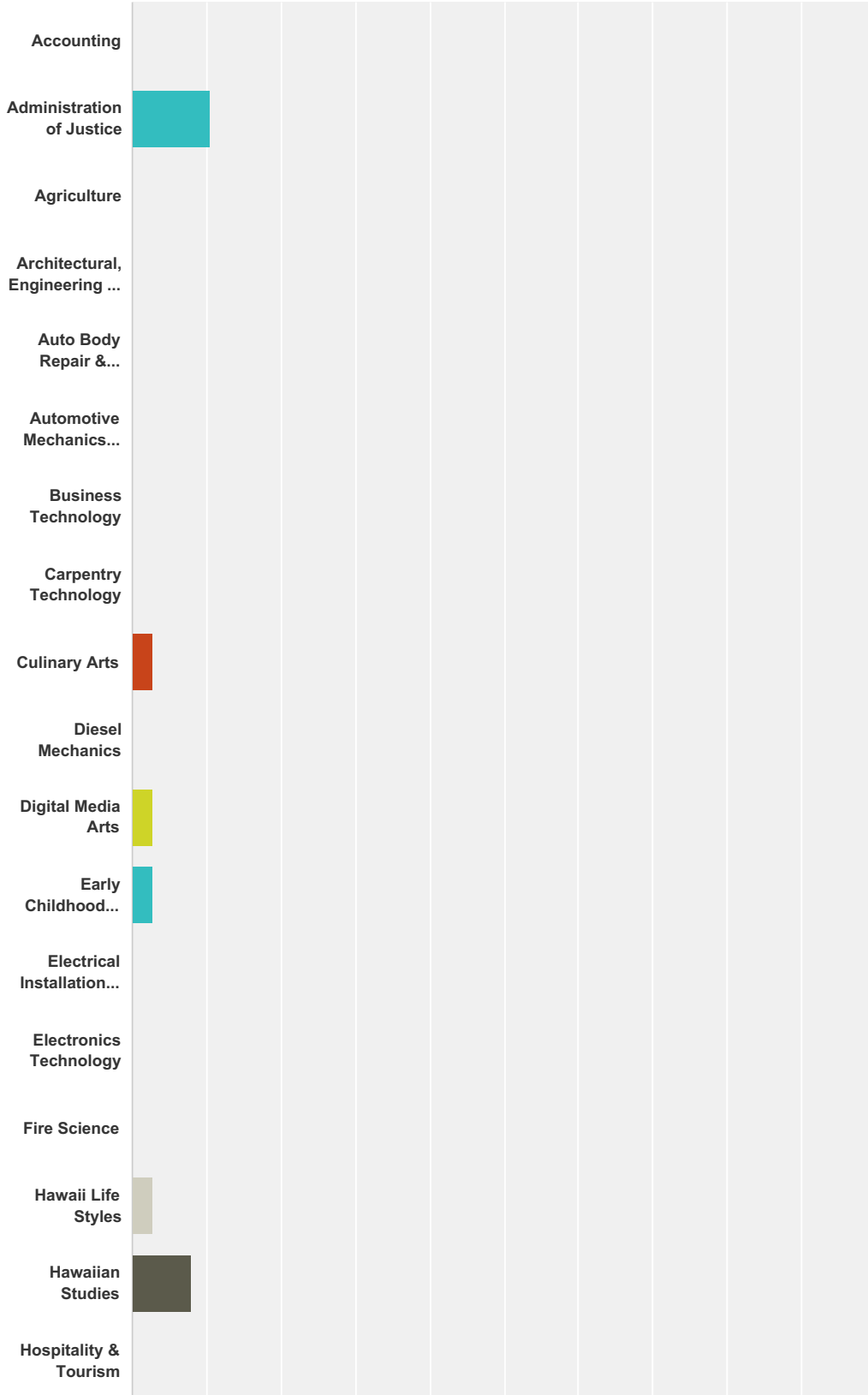

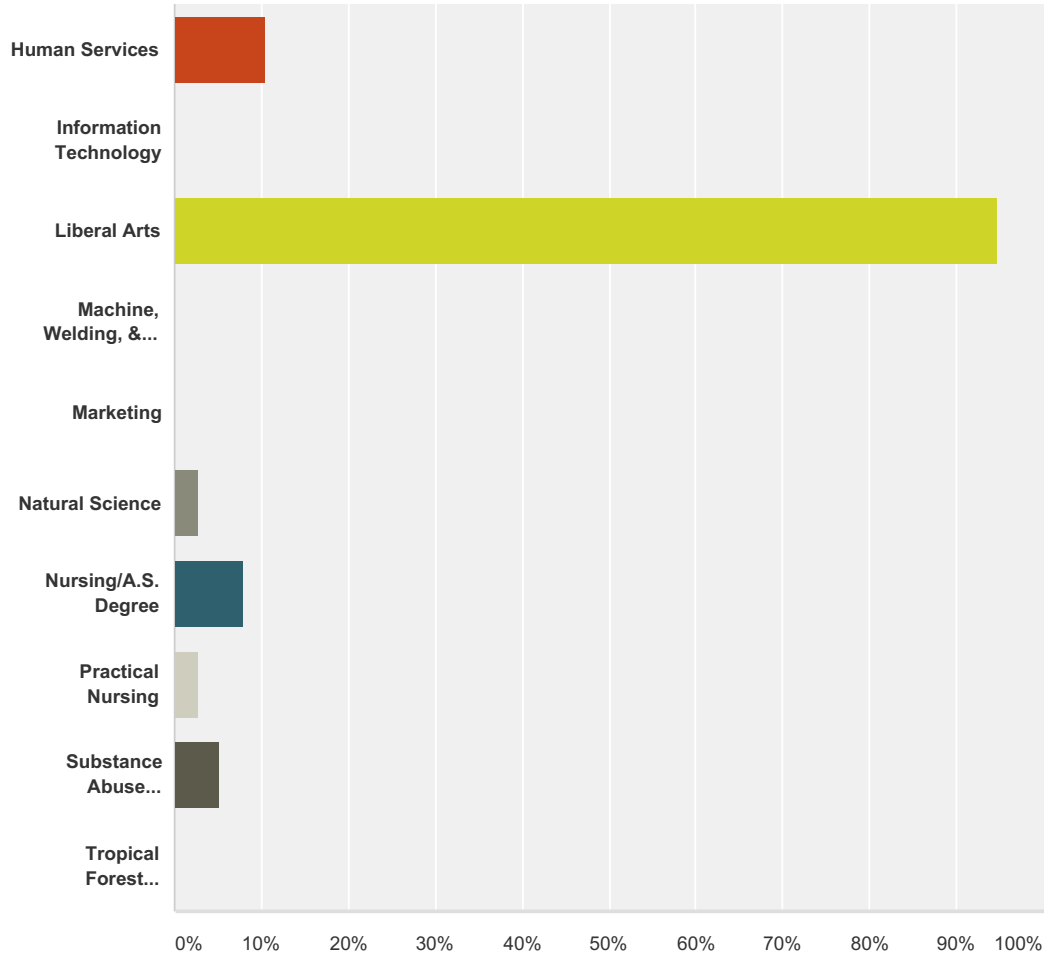

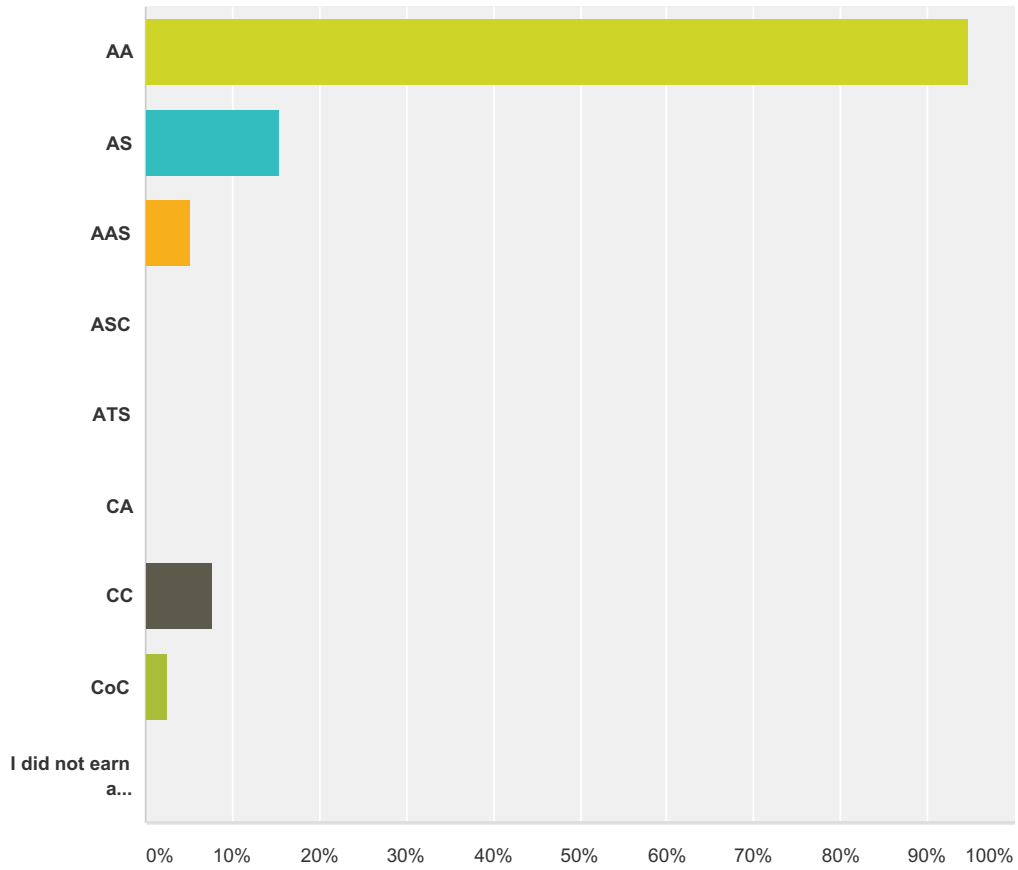

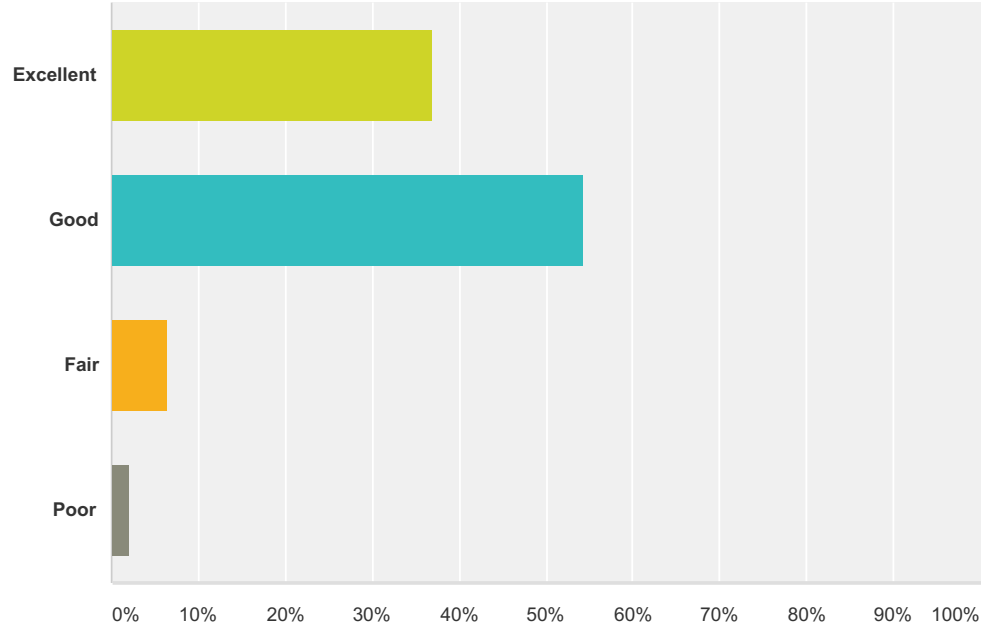

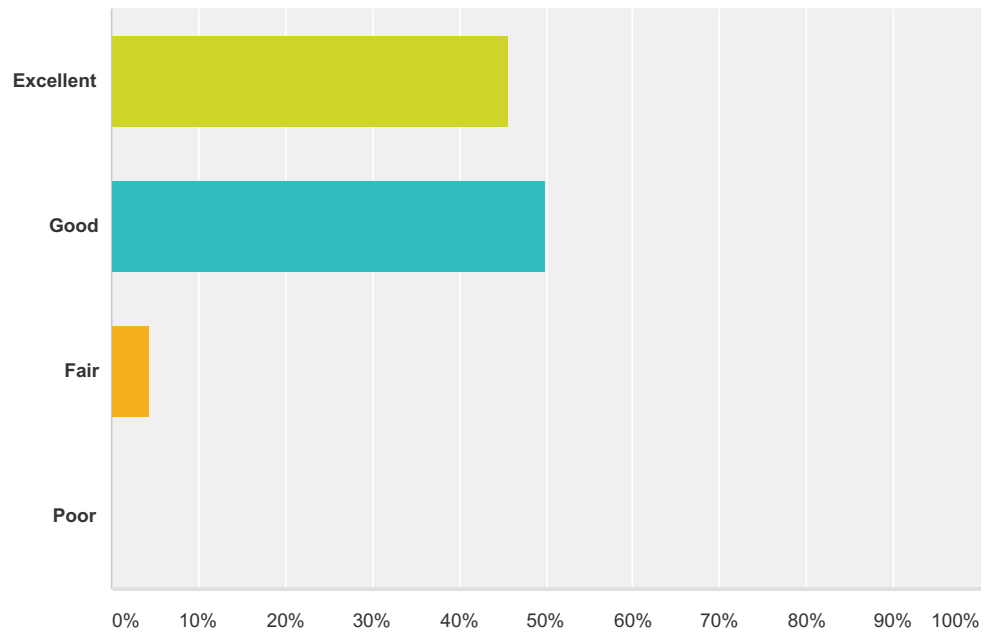

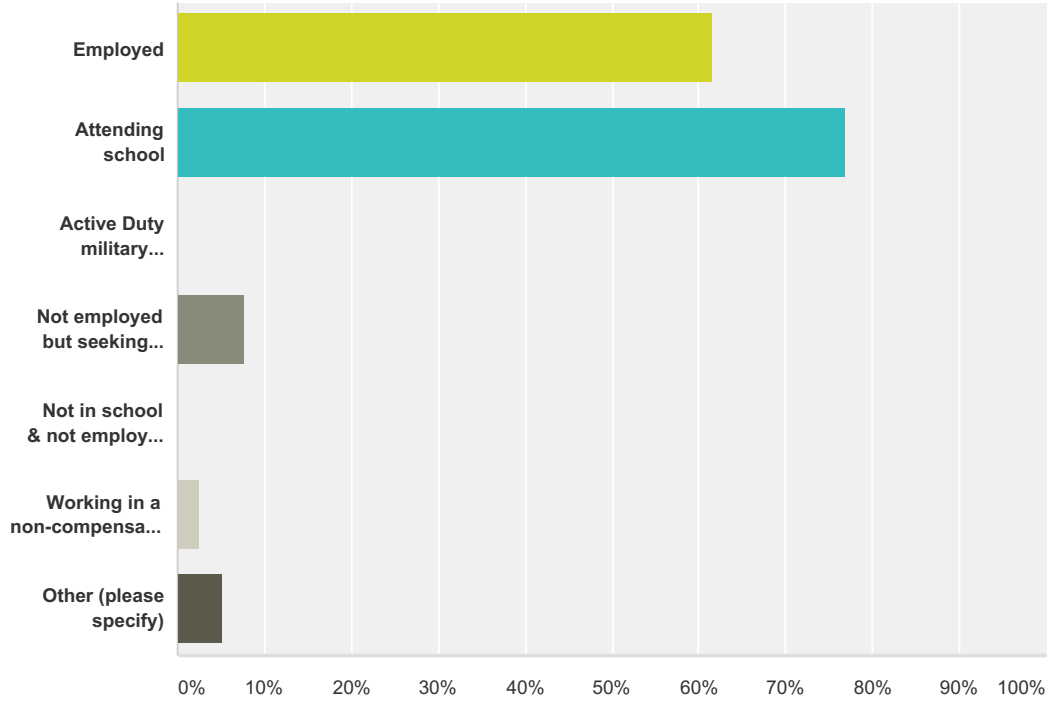

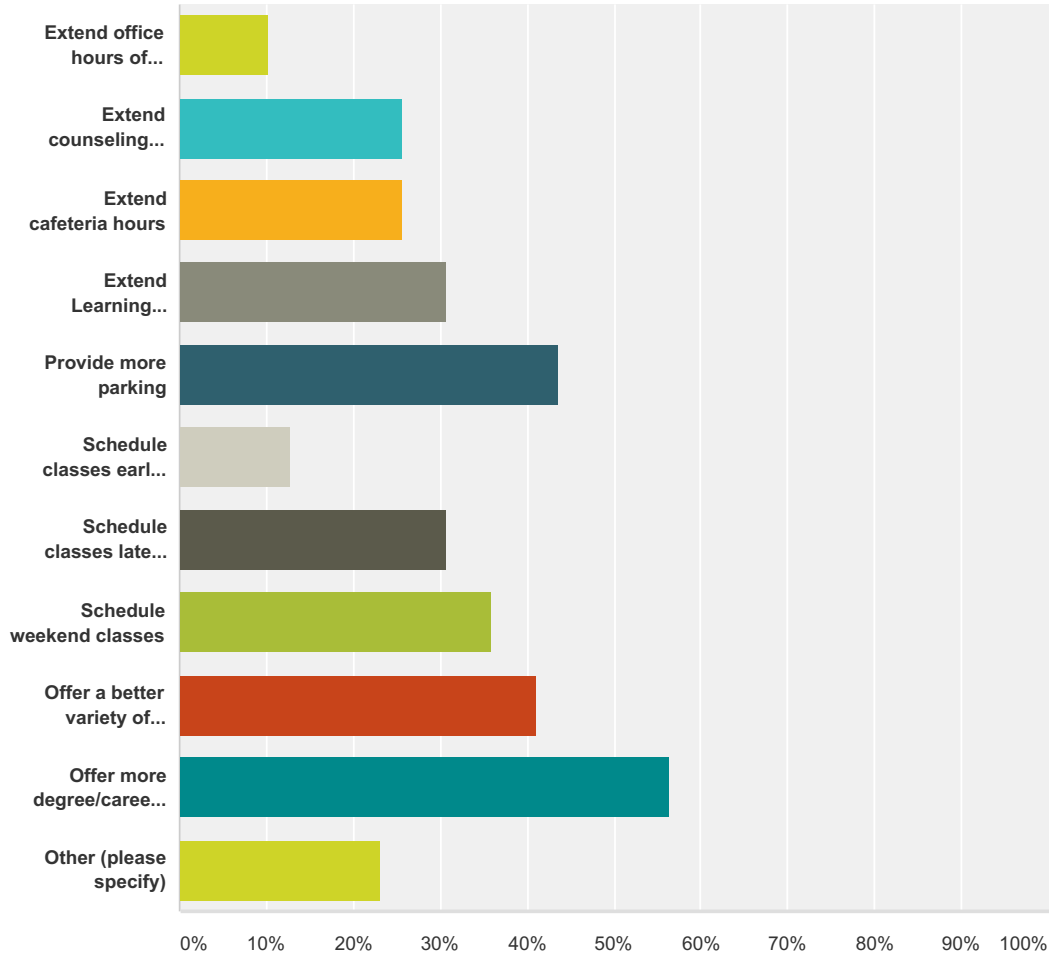

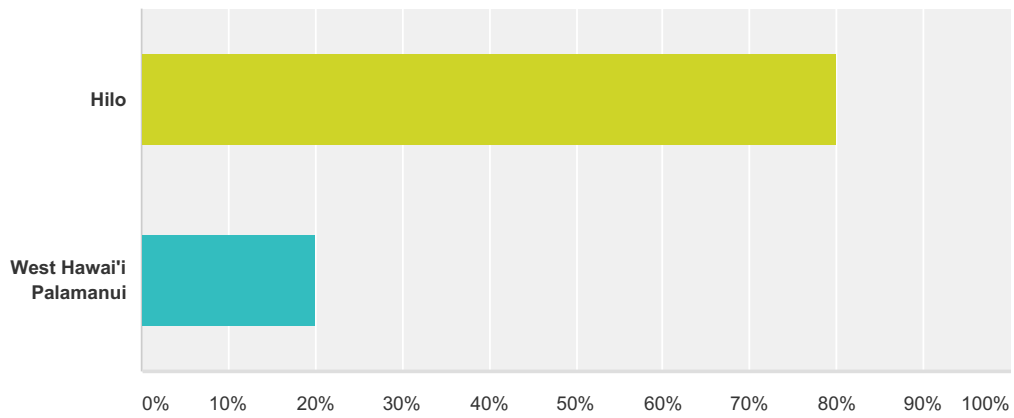
