UHCCP #5.208 Residency for Graduation

I. Purpose

The purpose of the policy is to facilitate and promote degree completion across the University of Hawai'i Community Colleges by standardizing academic residency requirements for graduation.

II. Related University Policies and Regulations

III. Responsibilities

Exceptions to the policy, to reduce the number of required credits, may be made on a case-by-case basis by the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs, or designee, in consultation with the appropriate campus personnel, at the degree-granting college.

IV. Procedures

- A. To graduate with a degree from a University of Hawai'i Community College, a student must have earned a minimum of 12 credits of program courses in the degree/major from that college.
- B. Colleges may not impose additional academic residency requirements for graduation with a degree.
