- 1. GEC met on January 18, 2017.
- 2. GEC reviewed 2 proposals. The Following 2 courses are presented in the order of review and approval by GEC.

GEC's recommendation to the Academic Senate is to approve the following courses for GE in the Primary and Secondary Designations as indicated:

- ANTH 200 with a Primary Designation under GELO 7 (Areas of Knowledge/Social Sciences) and Required Second Designations for Critical Thinking (GELO 3, required) (unanimous in favor)
- ASTR 110 with a Primary Designation under GELO 7 (Areas of Knowledge/Natural Sciences) and Required Second Designations for Critical Thinking (GELO 3, required) (unanimous in favor)
- 3. Last year's May 05, 2016 senate meeting a list of GEC recommended course were voted on and approved by the senate. Two of the courses (WS 175 and WS 176) from that list were passed as GELO 7(Areas of Knowledge/Social Science), when in fact the two courses were designated and approved by GEC under GELO 9/Cultural Diversity. GEC recommends that the senate rescind that vote by re-voting for the WS 175 and WS 176 to be designated as GELO 9/Cultural Diversity. This vote will document that the correct designation will be listed on the 17-18 catalog.
