

Graduation Requirements

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to describe the College's graduation requirements policy.

Background:

The College's practices in this area were reviewed by the Academic Senate in Spring 2002. The Senate's recommendations were submitted on April 15, 2002.

Policy:

A student must satisfy the graduation requirements of the ~~HawCC degree or certificate program in effect at the time he/she first enrolls as a classified student catalog year he/she selects, provided the catalog year selected is not prior to his/her initial enrollment at Hawai'i Community College, or the requirements in effect at the time of his/her graduation. A student whose enrollment is interrupted for two or more consecutive semesters (excluding summer sessions) must complete the requirements in effect at the time the student is readmitted or the requirements in effect at the time of his/her graduation.~~ A student may not select a catalog year of which they were not enrolled.

A MINIMUM 2.0 GPA IS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION IN ALL PROGRAMS.
