1. GEC met on April 19, 2017.
2. GEC reviewed 2 proposals. The Following 2 courses are presented in the order of review and approval by GEC.

**GEC's recommendation to the Academic Senate is to approve the following courses for GE in the Primary and Secondary Designations as indicated:**

- ENG 257A: Themes of Literature: Literature of Hawaii with a Primary Designation under GELO 7 (Areas of Knowledge/Social Sciences) and Required Second Designations for Critical Thinking (GELO 3, required) (**unanimous in favor**)
  - ENG 257E: Multi-Cultural Literature with a Primary Designation under GELO 7 (Areas of Knowledge/Natural Sciences) and Required Second Designations for Critical Thinking (GELO 3, required) (**unanimous in favor**)
3. The General Committee proposes that the Hawaii CC Academic Senate approve the following:

General Education Committee as a standing committee of the Senate. The purposes of this Committee are to review courses (both current and new proposals) for articulation into the multi-campus Foundations agreement and to engage in discussions at HawCC and in the UH system concerning general education course requirements, learning outcomes, and assessment.
