- ENG 257E: Multi-Cultural Literature with a Primary Designation under GELO 7 (Areas of Knowledge/Natural Sciences) and Required Second Designations for Critical Thinking (GELO 3, required) (unanimous in favor)

General Education Committee as a standing committee of the Senate. The purposes of this Committee are to review courses (both current and new proposals) for articulation into the multi-campus Foundations agreement and to engage in discussions at HawCC and in the UH system concerning general education course requirements, learning outcomes, and assessment.
