After proposing and receiving feedback from our constituents, the following six Level I questions, based on HawCC's six ILO's, are being submitted to the Faculty Senate for approval:

1. The learning environment supported and encouraged my ability to communicate in a variety of situations.

2. My experience at college has developed my critical thinking and problem solving skills.

3. The college has supported me to contribute to my community service in ways that are respectful of Hawai'i Island culture and the wider global community.
