GEC have put together a series of documents that will function as the process for certifying Foundations courses.

- 1. The proposal form, which courses wishing to get the Foundations designation will use to apply with.
- 2. Then, for *each* designation (FQ Quantitative Reasoning, FW Written Communication, FG Global and Multicultural Perspectives) the proposer will need to adequately answer the helpful questions to meet that Hallmark.

 *Note: Hallmarks are set by UH Manoa; however the helpful questions are campus-chosen.

Note: Foundations courses we are dealing with are only the "core" courses - ie. FQ (ie. math), FW (ie. Eng100 etc), and FG (ie. history) etc. not the "diversifications" courses (like Natural Sciences, or Social Sciences) which GEC will work on next.
