Resolution #2017-3

A resolution calling for only one part of the Course Evaluation System (CES) to be the responsibility of individual faculty members wherein the faculty have direct responsibility to the students through instruction and classroom management.

Whereas, the new Course Evaluation System (CES) is broken into four sections dealing with different levels of the college experience and,

Whereas, only one section of the CES directly deals with classroom management and instruction which is fully under the control of the instructor and,

Whereas, instructors should not be held accountable for CES items outside of their control and,

Whereas, course evaluations are an essential part of any tenure/promotion document where the faculty member analyzes student comments and course scores,

Be it resolved, that the Academic Senate of Hawai'i Community College will not hold individual faculty members accountable for CES questions outside their control in their tenure/promotion documents and,

Be it further resolved, that the Academic Senate of Hawai'i Community College encourages faculty members to analyze and discuss classroom management and instruction as reported in the CES in their tenure/promotion documents.
