Actions:

- In addressing a need identified during the accreditation self evaluation process, the DE Committee updated the <u>DE Policy (HAW 5.200)</u>. The revision passed through the EPC and then the Senate on March 23rd. This policy now identifies important practices for DE classes, including
 - a. how the College decides which classes to offer online,

- b. who will be able to teach online classes.
- c. how online classes will be scheduled, and
- d. how the College will evaluate and monitor online classes for quality, as well as how they meet national and accreditation expectations.
- 2. The DE Committee discussed and updated the definition of hybrid courses at the college.

- 2. Evaluation of online classes
