We met on September 25th, 2018. What happened?

- 1. The semester meeting schedule was set:
 - a. We'll meet October 23rd and November 20th.
 - b. Meetings will be conducted through Polycom RealPresence. (Joshua needs a computer with a camera and mic next time.)
- 2. Leanne and Kate presented a history of the DE Committee for the new members.
- 3. We discussed preparation for the visit of the Accreditation Team, including policies and practices we'd want to share with the visiting team.
- 4. Leanne revealed that the UH System LMS Review resulted in the decision that **the college will stay with Laulima for the next three years**. UH System will undergo its next review after that time.
- 5. We discussed the definition of a **hybrid class** for the purpose of defining this for the college this year. We're looking for input from all faculty.

Hybrid courses: Courses that replace 50% of face-to-face "seat time" with online instruction. Face-to-face instruction is reduced but not eliminated. In compliance with the US Department of Education credit hour definition and the UH System Credit Hour policy (Policy #5.228, May 2012), the combined face-to-face and online instructional time remains equivalent to a traditional face-to-face course.

The syllabus must indicate both in-class and online requirements including:

- a. The number of hours that are face-to-face vs. online
- b. The activities that will be held face-to-face vs. online
 - Student attendance/participation for the face-to-face hours is mandatory

On October 16th, 2018, Leanne and Kate met with members of the Accreditation Team to discuss Distance Education policies and practices at the college.
