**THE AUTOMOTIVE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM** prepares the student for employment as a general mechanic in a service station or auto dealer's shop, or as a specialty mechanic or a specialist on engine tune-ups or electrical systems.

## Entry Requirements

- Possess a valid driver's license
- Proficiency levels in reading, writing and/or mathematics are required to register for some or all of the Program courses:

SUBJECT AREA	MINIMUM PLACEMENT INTO COURSE
Mathematics	Math 22 or Math 50 or QM 120T or "C" or higher in QM 80
Reading	Eng 21 or ESL 21
