



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, HAWAII COMMUNITY COLLEGE AND CHAMINADE UNIVERSITY OF HONOLULU

This memorandum of agreement is entered into by and between the University of Hawaii on behalf of Hawaiii Community College (hereinafter referred to as "HawCC") and Chaminade University of Honolulu (hereinafter referred to as "Chaminade") to establish the guidelines for a 2+2 pathway leading to a Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education (BSECE) and Bachelor of Science Early Childhood Education with Montessori and PK-K Licensure (BSECE Montessori/PKK) through the Chaminade Extended University Accelerated Undergraduate Program. Both parties are entering into this agreement to coordinate and expand the undergraduate level early childhood education program for Hawai'i state residents who require distance learning delivery. This agreement is an updated version of the Articulation Agreement in 2013.

I. Admission requirements include:

A. Course requirements. Completion of the AS-ECED degree from Hawai'i Community College enables transfer students to waive the Chaminade BSECE and BSECE Montessori/PKK Pre-Major and all General Education requirements. Students transferring into the Chaminade BSECE or BSECE Montessori/PKK 2 plus 2 programs should take the courses identified in the table below as their coursework at Hawai'i Community College before transferring to Chaminade.

- B. Minimum G.P.A. of 2.0
- C. Two letters of recommendation (General Admission Requirement)
- D. General education course requirements are waived if a student has earned an associate degree from regionally accredited university.
- E. Chaminade ENG 102 is a prerequisite for all upper-division courses at Chaminade University but can be waived if a student takes HawCC ENG 215 or equivalent.

II. Under the terms of this Agreement, Hawai'i Community College shall:

- A. Identify a counselor/advisor at HawCC who will partner with Chaminade's advisor(s) to ensure timely and accurate advising information on pre-admission, admission, degree requirements, and other relevant advising information.
- B. Meet with Chaminade's faculty and/or administration on an annual, or as-needed basis, to discuss potential and planned curricular changes that may require revisions to this agreement.

III. Under the terms of this Agreement, Chaminade shall:

- A. Identify a counselor/advisor at Chaminade who will partner with HawCC's advisor(s) to ensure timely and accurate advising information on pre-admission, admission, degree requirements, and other relevant advising information.
- B. Meet with HawCC's faculty and/or administration on an annual, or as-needed basis, to discuss potential and planned curricular changes that may require revisions to this agreement.
- C. Offer all upper-division courses required for completion of the degree at the then-current tuition rate. An additional then-current technology fee also applies to all online courses (fee subject to review annually).
- D. Offer courses in the undergraduate program in four ten-week semesters throughout the year with the exception of Student Teaching and Student Teaching Seminar courses in the BSECE Montessori/PKK program which follow the HI DOE school semester schedule.
- E. Waive the initial application fee for students covered under this MOA.
- F. Offer the PK-K licensure route in the BSECE Montessori/PKK program only.

IV. Agreement Review and Termination

The Agreement will be reviewed annually by both parties. Termination of the Agreement, by either party, must be accompanied by written notification three months in advance of their intent to terminate. The contact person at HawCC will be the Early Childhood Education Program Co-Coordinator and the contact person at Chaminade will be the Early Childhood and Montessori Programs Director or Assistant Director.

V. Amendments

Both parties agree that any amendments to this Agreement, other than termination, shall be mutually agreed on in writing thirty days prior to the effective date before being undertaken.
